- The topics given were as follows: -
- 1. State of Fiscal Stimulus in India
- 2. Position in World Hunger Index- a misrepresented truth?
- 3. Trends of Public Investment in Higher Education in India
- Entries were invited in English, Hindi, or Punjabi. Prizes up to ₹3000 were also arranged.

GUEST LECTURE
