Technovation 2023

Technovation 2023 was a one day **inter-college IT Fest** which was organized by the department of Computer Science and IT, DAV College, Chandigarh on 27th March,2023. The Fest was organized with the **aim of building and increasing the confidence level of the students**, **providing them with an opportunity to showcase their creativity, help develop their debugging capabilities, query writing skill, web development and designing skills** and **stimulate their creative thinking**. Unique and varied set of technical competitive events were organized as a part the Fest. The following 4 competitive events were organized during the IT Fest:

- > Bug-D-Code
- > Movie Making
- Web Mania
- > SQL Maestro

The One-day event witnessed participation of over 100 students from various colleges affiliated to Panjab University. The participants exhibited utmost level of passion and spirit of competitiveness.

Movie Making

A Movie Making competition was organized with the aim of providing students from various colleges with an opportunity to discover and enhance their creative skills as filmmakers and produce amazing content without expensive software's **thereby making it about the person behind the equipment**. Participants were allowed to develop a movie using **Windows Movie Maker** and **Filmora 9** movie making applications.

Participants were required to develop a short film on any one of the following topics:

- ➢ G20 in India
- > VFX in movies
- Digital solutions for homes
- > AI in healthcare
- Aviation sector in India

Participants came up with very creative, well edited and attention grabbing work of art, each of which clearly communicated the indented message and enabled judges and audience gather cinematic perspectives of the young generation on wide spectrum of topics which included healthcare, geo politics and futuristic technologies.

Team of Manav Paul and Gautam from DCSA, PU won the 1st prize for designing a very engaging movie on the use of VFX in the movies.

SQL Maestro

SQL Maestro – A competitive event based on the field of database programming was organized to evaluate the query writing skills of the students and test their knowledge of the various concepts from the field of Database Management. Questionnaire of the competition compromised of 30 questions covering concepts such as **Data Abstraction**, **Data redundancy**, **Data Manipulation**, **Concurrent Access**, **Data Security etc**.

To test the analytical skills and subjective understanding of the participants, questions were divided into the categories such as **multiple choice question**, **one word answer questions** and **detailed query response questions**. Around 15 teams participated in the event and showcased their prowess in the field of Database Management. Riya Dutta from DCSA, PU won the first prize, Harshpreet Kaur from DCSA, PU won the second prize while the third prize was won by Gaurav from DAV College, Chandigarh.

Bug-D-Code

A code debugging event named Bug-D-Code was organized to test the code debugging abilities of the participants in core programming languages C and C++.

Each team was provided with a questionnaire comprising of 25 questions, each containing an error, covering range of topics such as **file handling, modular programming, automation, dynamic memory management** and **decision making**. Participants were required to analyze the code snippets and specify the nature of the error and the statement number where error was present.

15 teams from various colleges competed in the event. Team of Vanshu and Aditya from DAV College, Chandigarh won the first prize, team of Akshit and Brahampreet from DCSA, PU won the second prize while the team of Prabhjot Kaur and Sahibpreet Kaur from DCSA, PU won the third prize.

<u>Web Mania</u>

A web application designing and development competition was organized with an aim of providing students with a platform where they could unleash their creativity and to actualize their imagination.Besides providing students with a platform, the objective was also to check the abilities of students to implement **interactive features in static website elements**, **designing the interface** and **user experience of a web application**.

Participants were required to developweb application on any one of the following topics:

- Athletics
- Breaking Stereotypes
- **OTT Platform**
- Traffic Management using Integrated Control System

The competition was held under two categories:

<u>Web Mania for Beginners</u>: For the students of first year. They were allowed to create web application without data base connectivity

<u>Web Mania Unleashed</u>: For students studying in second year and onwards. They were required to create web application with database connectivity.

Participants came up with creative designs and user-friendly interface while covering the content and technological aspects.

Team of Arnav and Rahul from PGGC-46 won the first prize in the Web Mania for Beginners category for designing a website on Athletics while the team of Pursharth Joshi and Rajesh from DAV College, Chandigarh won the first prize in the Web Mania Unleashed category for creating a website on OTT platform.

Seminar on Machine Learning and Technology

A Seminar on Machine Learning & Technology was organized by the department of Computer Science & IT on 23rd February 2023. The seminar was organized in coordination with Plaksha University, Mohali.The resource person for the seminar was Shri Pawan Kumar, Associate Director for the Technology Leaders Program of Plaksha University. He described machine learning as one of the most exciting areas of technology at the moment and the technology which is set to revolutionize almost any area of human life and work. He specified that the biggest advantage of machine learning was that machine learning can review large volumes of data and discover specific trends and patterns that would not be apparent to humans.Shri Pawan Kumar elucidated the audience about the structure and design of Plaksha Technology Leaders Program. The seminar was extremely useful for students who wanted to understand fields of AI-ML, have an interest in technology start-ups and entrepreneurship and want to transit into data science, product management and tech leadership roles.

Career Counseling Seminar
